

October Volunteer Outing

Join us on Friday, October 9th at 6:00 p.m. at the Hamptons Pumpkin Patch and Corn Maze in Marshfield. This volunteer outing is for all volunteers and board members of the Ronald McDonald House and the Tooth Truck.

Everyone will be greeted by a RMH staff member in the parking lot. You will be given a ticket (guests will need to pay at this time). After you get your ticket, you are free to do whatever you want the rest of the evening!

There are two kinds of tickets- volunteers can get either ticket for FREE!

-Red tickets: All access tickets, covers everything the property offers (\$5 per guest)

-Blue tickets: Covers everything EXCEPT the corn maze (\$2 per guest)

Note: if you pick a pumpkin from the pumpkin patch, you are responsible for the cost

We will have several things going on through the evening:

- Food, snacks, and s'mores
- Hayride
- Pumpkin patch
- Bonfire with fun games and stories
- Corn maze (with red ticket only)

Directions: From Springfield Missouri, take I-44 East 26.3 miles to exit 100.
Then go west on 38 (left) 8.5 miles to Hampton's on right

or

From Springfield Missouri, take Hwy 65 north 17.7 miles to Fair Grove Exit, then right on 125 1 mile. Then take Hwy E left 6 miles to Hwy 38 turn left and go 3 miles to Hampton's on right
